Canine Courtesy: All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates at all times except when competing. You are responsible for picking up after the animals in your care. It is expressly understood that every dog at this test/trial is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises. BCKC is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. NOTE: *Dogs not entered are not allowed beyond the parking area.*

Entered dogs and handlers are permitted on the trial grounds May 22nd & 23rd from 6AM until 7PM. Dogs are not permitted in trial arenas before their event. No exhibitors will be allowed in the trial arena without permission.

On-site Camping: Overnight camping is not permitted at the site.

1. All classes will be held outdoors.
2. All dogs nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration are eligible to participate.
3. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are lame, blind, or deaf or have open sores shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is bandaged, stitched or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. If course conditions warrant, protective footwear may be worn if approved by the Judge.
4. Bitches in season shall be eligible to participate. They shall run at the end of Test classes and in catalog order in Trial classes. Please notify the Trial Secretary before the beginning of the class if the bitch is in season.
5. At the handler's option dogs may wear flat buckle collars, snap collars, or slip collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Prong and electric collars (live or dummy) are prohibited on the grounds. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area.
6. Dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the owner, provided the higher class is offered and is not filled. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order.
7. *AKC Herding Regulations* are available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390. The rules have been revised as of September, 2006. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with the rules and regulations.
8. There is little shade and no protection from the weather at the trial site. Please bring tents, shade cloths, chairs, etc., to make your day more comfortable for you and your dog.
9. Proof of current rabies must be furnished upon request.
10. No concessions will be available at the trial site.

GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

- **Entry Fees:** Fee is \$55.00 per entry (sheep) \$45.00 (ducks) (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee). Make all checks and money orders payable to Burlington County Kennel Club. Foreign exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.. **INCLUDE SIGNATURE WAIVER ON OVERNIGHT OR EXPRESS DELIVERY.**
- Entry fees shall **not** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- **Entries:** Telegraph, Telephone, Email, and Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- No Entries shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **Post-Dated Checks and Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$30.00 to each returned check.
- Exhibitors are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing of entries.
- No refund on duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request.
- For entries received same time/same date, trial entries shall receive preference.

Declining Entries: The Burlington County Kennel Club, Inc. may decline any entries or may remove any dog from its event for cause, but in each such instance shall file good and sufficient reasons for doing so with the American Kennel Club.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Trial classes:

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 5th place dogs in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes.

Rosettes for placements in each Trial class:

First Place.....Blue
Second Place.....Red
Third Place.....Yellow
Fourth Place.....White
Fifth Place.....Pink
Qualifying Score.....Dark Green

High-in-Trial: Blue, Red, Yellow rosette. Etched glass item.

Reserve High-in-Trial: Red, Yellow, White Rosette. Etched glass item.

High Score Ducks each day: Pewter magnet

High Score Sheep each day: Pewter magnet

High Combined Score: Etched glass picture frame offered by DeFrances Pembroke Welsh Corgis to the dog with the highest combined scores for sheep and ducks over both days. Dog must be entered on both types of stock on both days. Only qualifying scores will be included in High-Combined Score.

Qualifying Score: Dog toy

Test Classes:

Qualifying runs shall receive a green rosette with white button and white center streamer and a dog toy.
