BCKC ANNUAL AWARDS - REQUIREMENTS

The Annual Awards were instituted to provide recognition to active Club members whose dogs (owned or co-owned) received AKC titles or degrees during the previous Club year. The Awards are presented each year at the Annual Awards Banquet to those members who have fulfilled the following requirements:

1. ***To be eligible for an Annual Award:*** a dog must first earn an AKC recognized degree or title within the official Club year for which the award is given (July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012).

To apply for an award: The owner/co-owner must be a member in good standing, having paid dues, and demonstrated their willingness to support the Club by attending 3 meetings, and contributes 16 hours of work to our Club activities.
(The Board of BCKC determines the activity requirements.)
3. ***For Championship Titles:*** The applicant must have been a member and have owned or co-owned the dog *through 8 points, including two qualifying majors.*
4. ***For Obedience and Agility Degree/Titles:*** The applicant must have been a member and have owned or co-owned the dog through two qualifying legs for any degree.
5. ***For Field Trial Awards, Hunting Titles and Earth Dog Titles:*** The applicant must have been a member and owned or co-owned the dog during the majority of the dog's points and or wins.
6. ***For Tracking Titles:*** The applicant must have been a member and owned or co-owned the dog at the time that the dog qualified.
7. ***For Herding Titles:*** The applicant must have been a member and owned or co-owned the dog at the time the dog earned the title.
8. ***For Lure Coursing Titles:*** The applicant must have been a member and owned or co-owned the dog when the junior or senior coursing titles were earned or through 8 points including two qualifying majors of the lure coursing field championship.
9. ***For CGC Certificates:*** The applicant must have been a member and have earned the CGC within the official club year.
10. ***In the case of co-ownership:*** The Club will provide only one award per dog. If duplicate awards are desired, they must be ordered and prepaid, within the deadline for the year's awards.
11. ***For subsequent titles earned by the same dog:*** The Club will provide recognition by engraving the AKC title on small metal plates which can be fastened directly into the original wood award.
12. ***Responsibility of the members:*** Members must send the required documentation for titles or degrees obtained by their dogs to the Chairman of the Awards Committee. Confirmation of wins is verified from AKC records. The Board of BCKC approves all award applications.
